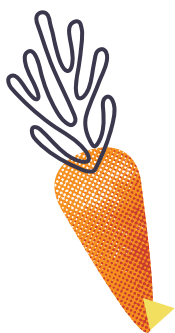

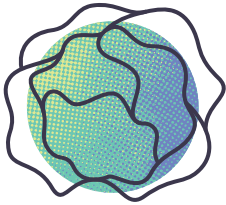

KNOWING NAMIBIA

Whether you're looking for tranquility, adventure or an escape to nature, Namibia might just be the destination for you. Pack your bags for this place before everyone else does.



Namibia finds itself described by plenty of adjectives—vast, endless, majestic, and so on. But, quite frankly, none do justice to encapsulate the feeling that is Namibia. This African destination lets you enjoy extreme proximity to nature, with its colossal red rock mountains, shifting sand dunes and abundant wildlife. To give you some perspective, this country is twice the size of Germany, yet only houses about two million people, making it one of the least populated countries in the world. That's ideal for those of you who travel to find some peace and solitude!

If you're tempted to pack your bags and jet-set to this land of unparalleled landscapes, make sure the following destinations find a place in your itinerary without fail!

1. Etosha National Park

Etosha National Park is one of Namibia's most famous nature conservation area, and one of the most significant game reserves in Africa. It is home to a large variety of mammals and birds. The name Etosha is derived from Oshiwambo and means "big, white place". More than 100 mammal species and 340 different species of birds are found in the park. The unique floodlit watering holes also make this place a wildlife photographer's dream! The other spectacular feature is the fact that the Park

surrounds the vast Etosha salt pan. The pan itself is usually dry and only fills with water briefly in the summer, but is enough to stimulate the growth of a blue-green algae which lures thousands of flamingos. Fun fact: the salt pan is so large, it can be seen from space.

2. Sossusvlei

Africa's largest conservation area—the Namib-Naukluft National Park—hosts Sossusvlei as its most famous attraction. Sossusvlei is a large, white, salt and clay

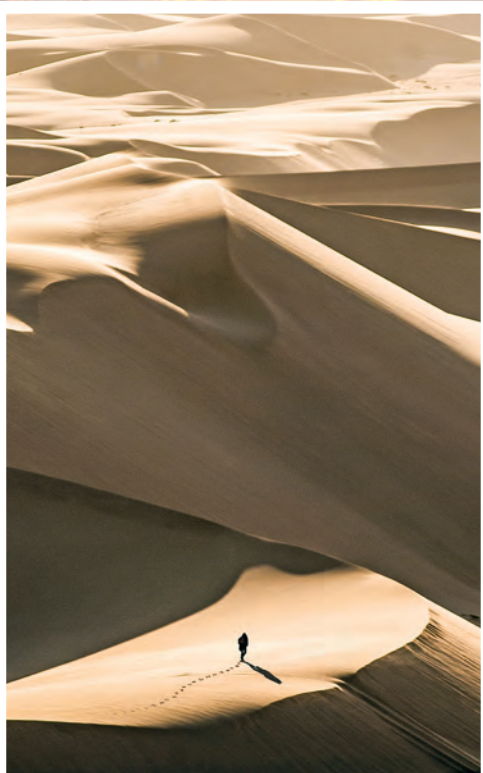

pan, created by the Tsauchab river that flows through the Sesriem Canyon every 5 to 10 years and is surrounded by large red dunes. The dunes in this area are some of the highest in the world, making them a breathtaking landscape to witness. This region remains bone-dry, yet houses a variety of animals and plants who have adapted to survive the harsh desert conditions of the area. Tourists can even enjoy camping in the surrounding area, and experience a night under the tallest dunes in the world.

3. Fish River Canyon Park

The Fish River Canyon is the second largest canyon





worldwide, after the Grand Canyon in the USA. The canyon is formed by the Fish River, one of the longest in Africa. One of the best ways to experience the Fish River Canyon Park fully is to sign up for a hike—the Fish River Canyon Trail (which covers a length of 85km) is very popular among tourists. However, it's best to keep in mind that the weather is harsh, dry and hot—so this trek is definitely not for the faint-hearted.

4. Swakopmund

If you're tired of conservation parks or if you're looking for a break from your spell of solitude, heading to Swakopmund will be a wise decision. Called the activity centre of Namibia, this is a western coastal town that is a popular beach destination. It was founded in 1892 as the main harbour for German South West Africa, and it still boasts of German colonial architecture. When here, you must stroll down the coastal road which is flanked by dunes on the one side and by the Atlantic Ocean on the other. Excursions can be made 30 km south to Walvis Bay, as well as up north to the



fishing paradise of Henties Bay or to Cape Cross to one of the world largest seal colonies.

5. Luderitz

If you study Luderitz's location on the map, you'll spot it planted between the Namib Desert and the South Atlantic Coast—that makes two contrasting climatic conditions come together. This town also boasts of a heavy colonial German influence, which you can easily spot in their art, architecture and even street names. On a visit to this quaint

town, don't miss the chance to visit the neighbouring ghost town of Kolmanskop, which was once a hub for diamond mining. Sand dunes have now overtaken the town, making it both eerie and beautiful.

6. Waterberg Plateau Park

The Waterberg Plateau Park is located in northern Namibia, and named after the large sandstone red rock plateau that serves as a sanctuary for endangered animals. Visitors can spot animals such as buffalo,

rhinoceroses and antelope. It is home to more than 200 species of birds. Wildlife enthusiasts can sign up for hikes through the Waterberg Plateau Park; these are allowed only through certain months such as April and November, and require strict permits and guides. You can also choose to camp in locations in and around the park.

7. Windhoek

Welcome to Namibia's capital and largest city—Windhoek. Whether you're interested





in Namibian history or wanting to start a lengthy safari through the country, it's most likely to start in this capital city. The Parliament of Namibia and the old church called the Christuskirche are some major tourist attractions. There are also several markets in the city that will satiate your shopping needs, and where you'll find plenty of souvenirs to take back home.

8. Skeleton Coast National Park

This coastal stretch across Namibia gets its name from the two sources: the large number of whales that lost their life here and whose skeletons could be seen all over the place and secondly, from the numerous ships that have stranded at the Skeleton Coast thanks to the

thick fog, the rough sea, unpredictable currents and stormy winds. Despite these climatic anomalies, the Skeleton Coast has a number of wild animals to observe. It is also a large breeding colony for 2,00,000 cape fur seals, spotted at the Cape Cross Seal Reserve, which makes this place very popular with tourists.

9. Walvis Bay

Walvis Bay is a city that houses the largest harbour in Namibia. It is abundantly populated with birdlife such as flamingos, pelicans and Damara terns, and aquatic life such as dolphins, whales and Cape fur seals. Boat rides in the ocean are very popular among tourists here, to spot dolphins and

seals, with the seals occasionally jumping right into the boat. Birdwatching on the wetlands is also something you can enjoy.

10. Epupa Falls

On the border between Namibia and Angola, in the region known as Kaokoland, is where you'll find Epupa Falls. These waterfalls are created by the Kunene River and are surrounded by colored rock formations, palm trees and fig trees. If you're visiting these falls, you can plan to stay in the surrounding lodges and camp sites, and enjoy activities such as swimming, hiking, birdwatching and even rafting along the river.


